

We hope this newsletter finds you well this year. We are continuing landscape maintenance and tree trimming.

We have taken noticed that someone is spraying roundup around many of the headstones. We appreciate the effort that someone is spending their time and money doing this, However, there is nothing that looks as nice as having the cemetery cut and trimmed smoothly. If you kill the grass around the stones then what's left is dirt. Chemical herbicides (roundup that contain glyphosate-based herbicide) contain salts and are often acidic – conditions which can be harmful to marble and limestone. Please refrain from spraying chemicals. We weed wack when needed. We cut and trim before Mother's Day, Father's Day and Memorial Day.



We would like to thank American Legion Post #110 of Aurora, Oregon for putting the flags on all the Veterans headstones in our Cemetery. If you have had a loved one who served, and is missing a flag holder, please let us know in the return envelope. The Butteville Pioneer Cemetery board appreciates the donations that you send in each year for the betterment of your Cemetery.

The Butteville Cemetery was first established in 1836. In 1894 it was moved and incorporated on land donated by A.E.M. Cone and named the Butteville Cemetery Association, Inc.

Within our three acres we have people well known in Oregon History. Six descendants of Daniel Boone. His grandson, Alphonso Boone founded the Boones Ferry at Wilsonville. Six members of Alphonso Boone's family are buried at Butteville. Another is F.X. Matthieu, and wife Rosa, whose vote at Champoeg put the Oregon Territory into the United States.
