Berna Harper Croco moved to Butteville in 1942 when she was 10 years old. Her parents purchased the Vandeleur house from the Donahues and she attended Butteville School that fall.

She was always interested in the pioneers of the area who are buried in our cemetery - the Boones, F.. X. Matthieu, the Whitneys of Broadacres, The Fellers of Donald, Ryans - too many to mention them all. She has 14 members of her family interred here, including her husband, Bill. Berna said "It was a privilege to keep the treasury records for 23 years". Time and distance are the reasons she cannot continue.

The Butteville Cemetery was first established in 1836. In 1894 it was moved and incorporated on land donated by A.E.M. Cone and named the Butteville Cemetery Association, Inc.

Within our three acres we have people well known in Oregon History. Six descendants of Daniel Boone. His grandson, Alphonso Boone founded the Boones Ferry at Wilsonville. Six members of Alphonso Boone's family are buried at Butteville. Another is F.X. Matthieu, and wife Rosa, whose vote at Champoeg put the Oregon Territory into the United States.
